Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA

Next week our parish will take up the Collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA (AMS). The AMS relies solely on private donors in support of its mission, "Serving those who serve" and its ministry to provide the same pastoral care and services to Catholics serving in the US Armed Forces, enrolled in Military Academies, undergoing treatment at any of the 153 Veteran Medical Centers, working in civilian jobs for the federal government beyond US borders, and the families of these populations, as does any other Catholic diocese. While the salaries and retirement of Catholic military chaplains are paid for by the US Government, the AMS receives no funding from government or the military for its programs and services.
