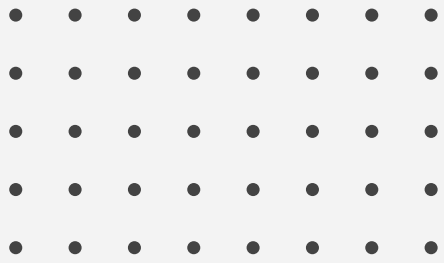

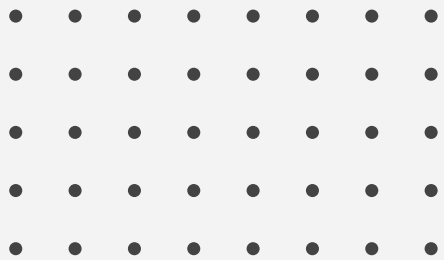

- Came through first sin
- What kind of story are you living?
- Should I live differently because death is coming?

JUDGMENT



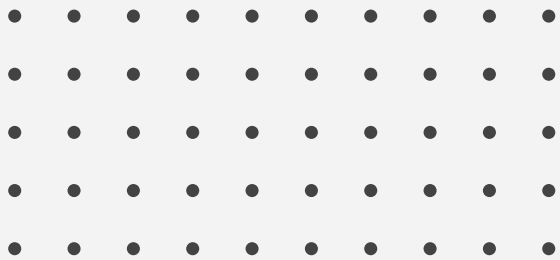
- We all have free will - free to choose
- Choices we make today affect our future, others around us, and our eternity
- “It’s no accident whether we end up in Heaven or Hell”
- Where are your choices leading you?

HELL

“If you choose to deny God day after day in this life, then why would you want to live forever with him in eternity.”

- Imagine: your worst day x1000
- CCC 1033 “Definitive self-exclusion from communion with God”
- Eternal suffering
- No truth, beauty, goodness, or peace
- Sadness, self-loathing, paranoia, angst, despair
- Not usually one single choice that leads to Hell, but many choices against God





HEAVEN

- Best day x1000
- “Supreme, definitive happiness”
- Fulfillment of the deepest human longings

PURGATORY

- Airport security
- Pit stop before heaven - always leads to Heaven
- Undergo purification of attachment to sin to achieve holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven
