Pope Francis' mortal remains carried to St. Peter's Basilica

The body of Pope Francis was transferred to St. Peter's Basilica on Wednesday morning in a rite led by Cardinal Kevin Farrell, Camerlengo of the Holy Roman Church. Over 20,000 people gathered in St. Peter's Square to pay their respects during the solemn procession. The liturgy included prayers, a Gospel reading, and the chanting of the Litany of the Saints. The funeral Mass will be held in St. Peter's Square on Saturday, April 26, at 10 AM, presided over by Cardinal Giovanni Battista Re,

Dean of the College of Cardinals.
