Our Lady of Sorrows September 15th

Our Lady of Sorrows is celebrated annually on September 15th. This day holds great significance as it commemorates the seven sorrows that the Virgin Mary experienced throughout her life. These sorrows include the prophecy of Simeon, the flight into Egypt, the loss of the child Jesus in the temple, the meeting of Jesus and Mary on the way to Calvary, the crucifixion, the taking down of the body of Jesus from the cross, and the burial of Jesus.

The feast of Our Lady of Sorrows invites us to reflect on Mary's sorrows and how they relate to our lives. We can experience similar sorrows, such as illness, loss of loved ones, and other personal struggles. However, just as Mary remained faithful to God in the midst of her sorrows, we, too, are called to have faith and trust in God's plan for us. Mary, Lady of Sorrows, pray for us.
