The society for the Propagation of the Faith, one of four Pontifical Mission Societies and the one behind the *World Mission Sunday* efforts, began when a French laywoman, over 200 years ago, answered her brothers' request for prayers for his mission as a priest in Africa. She summoned her friends into prayer groups, asking them to pray daily and give a penny a week to the church in the missions. This collection of pennies became what, in 1926, Pope Pius XI called *World Mission Sunday*. Held each year, this is an effort of the entire Church to help over 1,100 dioceses that cannot sustain themselves because they are too poor, young or actively persecuted.
