Saint of the Week:

St. Pius of Pietrelcina

1887-1968

Feastday:
Sept. 23rd

Born Francesco Forgione to an impoverished family, he longed to be a friar since childhood. As a child, he had the ability to see guardian angels and speak with Jesus and the Virgin Mary. Because his family was so poor, he had to work as a shepherd. This meant his education would suffer as he fell behind those able to attend school regularly. In addition, he had gastroenteritis at 6 and typhoid fever at 10. After being evaluated by a nearby community of monks, he was told he needed more schooling before joining. For him to fulfill his dream of becoming a friar, his father went to America to earn the money to pay for a tutor. At 16, he became a novitiate to the Capuchin Order, taking the name Brother Pius (Fra Pio). His ordination to the priesthood was in 1910 but was allowed to stay home because of his ongoing poor health. During WWI, he was drafted and sent into the medical service. His poor health got him sent home only for him to be recalled and dismissed again in March 1916. Sept. 1916, while listening to confessions, he suffered great pains in his hands and feet. He noticed the stigmata and despite the open wounds, they never got infected and smelled of roses. In 1956, he used his notoriety to open a hospital. Although his life was marked by illness and suffering, he endured all with gratitude and love. He was canonized in 2002, by Pope John Paul II and is the patron of civil defense volunteers, adolescents, and the village of Pietrelcina.

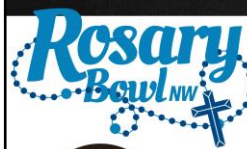
