WEEKLY SPIRITUAL ETIQUETTE 1

HOPE: HOLD ON, PAIN ENDS

There are moments in life when the pain feels heavy and the waiting feels long. We carry struggles in our hearts: - problems, fears, and uncertainties. But today, remember this: HOPE means: **Hold On, Pain Ends.**

To hope does not mean everything is already okay. It means we trust God even when things are not yet okay. Pain is real - but it is not forever. Darkness comes - but it will pass. Even Good Friday did not last. Easter came. So, if you are struggling right now, **hold on, pain ends.** All human wisdom is summed up in two words: - **Wait and Hope.** If it were not for hope the heart would break. Hold on in prayer. Hold on to the Lord. Because God is with you, and He will see you through.

Hope is the strength of the soul. As long as there is hope, a person continues to pray, to rise again, to love, and to keep walking. Hope whispers: This is not the end. God is not finished yet. Do not give up. Keep praying. Keep trusting. Keep hoping." As the Psalm says: **"Weeping may endure for a night, but joy comes in the morning"** (Psalm 30:5).

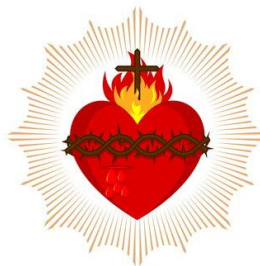
