OF ABORTIONS  
IN OREGON

\*Single filers with a household income of \$75,000 or less can claim up to \$50 when filing your Oregon taxes. Joint filers with a household income of less than \$150,000 can claim up to \$100. Individuals with federal adjusted gross incomes over \$75,000 or joint filers with combined adjusted gross incomes exceeding \$150,000 no longer qualify for the Political Tax Credit. However, every contribution is still extremely valuable to our mission.

It's a credit, not a deduction.

Most joint filers can give up to \$100 to a qualified political organization and most single filers can give up to \$50 and then receive that money back when they file their Oregon tax return.
