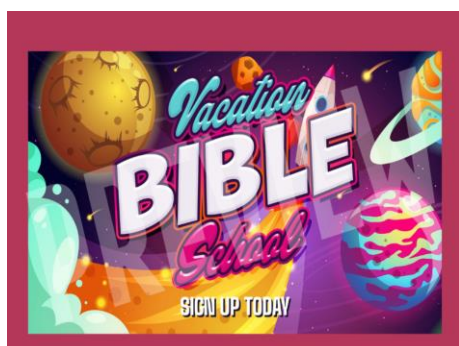
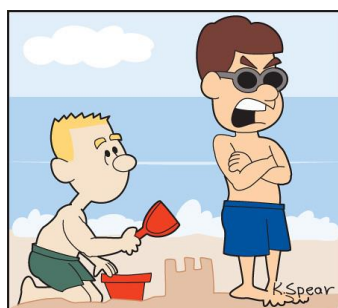

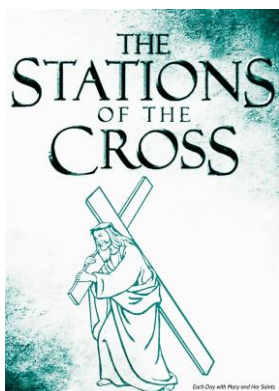
Vacation Bible School, VBS????????
