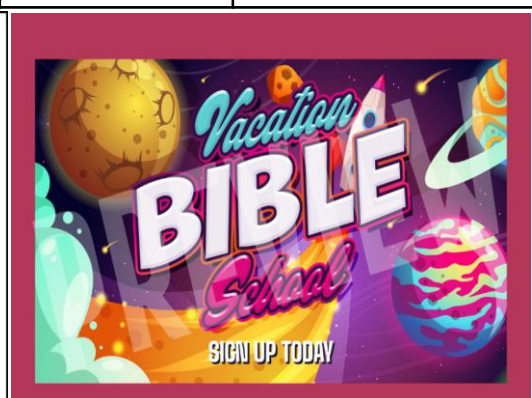
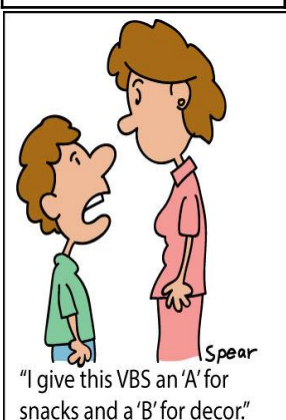

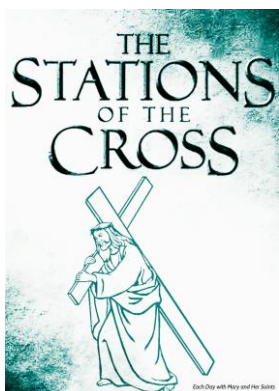
## Vacation Bible School, VBS?????????
