SAINT OF THE WEEK

Blessed Angela Salawa

September 9, 1881-March 12, 1922

Blessed Angela Salawa was born to a large family in Siepraw, Poland, near Krakow. At 16, Angela moved to Krakow to work as a maid. When Angela started working, she would spend each paycheck going out and living frivolously. During this time, her faith also started to fade.

Angela's sister often tried to call Angela on to conversion. It wasn't until a wedding, that Angela had a vision of Jesus standing near her, asking her to follow him that Angela had a change of heart.

After her conversion, Angela started a group of young women to study the faith together. In 1912, she joined the lay Third Order Franciscans. Angela also had a desire to religious vocation, but was not healthy enough.

At the outbreak of WWI, Angela tended to wounded soldiers and prisoners of war in her spare time. Around this time, Angela was falsely accused of stealing, and fired from her job. She bore her suffering in sickness and false accusations with humility. She often wrote in her journal her strong desire for God's will.

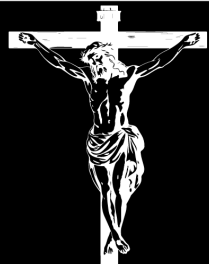


Holy Thursday Washing of the Feet

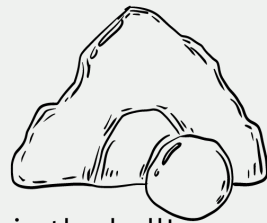
