"Today bring to Me the Souls who are detained in Purgatory..."

#### Saint of the week

St. John Baptist de La Salle April 30, 1651- April 7, 1719

St. John Baptist de LaSalle was born into a wealthy family in Reims, France. La Salle was well educated, which was a luxury just for the privileged at the time. By the age of 11, John was committed to becoming a priest. While in seminary, both of his parents died within a year of each other, so John briefly left his studies to care for his younger siblings. Despite the responsibilities to his family, John was ordained at the age of 26. Within 2 years, he also received his doctorate in theology.

John is known for his innovative work in Catholic education. Although he did not seek to reform, or even be involved in education, it is something that continually came up in his life. First in overseeing the education of his siblings, and later in running a school for poor, at risk

boys. John founded a new order, dedicated to education called the Brothers of Christian Schools, many of whom still over see La Sallian schools throughout the world today. John fought to reform education that would fit all, not just the rich.

Let us remember, that we are in the holy presence of God.


