### Prayer of St. Bernadette

#### SAINT OF THE WEEK St. Bernadette Soubirous January 7, 1844- April 16, 1879

St. Bernadette was born in Lourdes, France to a very poor family. Bernadette was the oldest of 9 children. As a toddler, she contracted cholera and experienced poor health for the rest of her life.

On February 11, 1858, while gathering firewood with her younger sister, Bernadette had a vision of a beautiful woman. The woman smiled at Bernadette then grabbed her rosary, making the sign of the cross. Bernadette knelt and joined her in prayer, but Bernadette's sister did not see the lady. Three days later, Bernadette returned to the spot of her vision with her sister and some friends. The lady appeared again, but only Bernadette could see her. One friend threw holy water on the spot, while another threw a rock. When this happened, the lady disappeared.

A few days later, the lady asked Bernadette to return every day for two weeks, and Bernadette obeyed.

On February 25, the lady told Bernadette to drink and wash in the spring near by. The next day Bernadette returned to do so, and the muddy spring was clean.

On March 25, Bernadette asked the lady her name and Mary replied "I am the Immaculate Conception."

The town of Lourdes became divided over young Bernadette's visions. However, church authorities investigated and eventually a chapel was built, according to Mary's instructions. Bernadette did not like all the attention, and soon joined the Sisters of Notre Dame at Nevers. Bernadette's life was marked by humility and sacrifice.


