St. Joseph

Feast Day: March 19

Not much is known about St. Joseph, the foster father of Jesus. All of the information we have about him comes from the Bible.

St. Joseph is a descendent of King David, though Joseph lived a humble life as a carpenter. We can tell that he is not rich because Joseph offered a sacrifice of two pigeons, instead of a lamb during the Presentation in the Temple. However, Joseph was always ready to listen and obey God's commands.

It is not known exactly when Joseph died, but it is presumed it was before Jesus started his public ministry, as he is not mentioned in the Bible during this time.

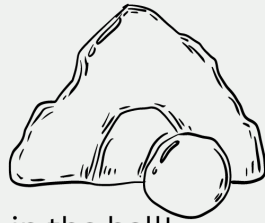
